A recommendation was brought forward from the Committee of the Whole addressing this matter.

The current H1N1 vaccinations schedule for the local area is totally inadequate for lobster fishermen and others involved in the lobster industry as the vaccinations are scheduled to take place on December 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> at the Island & Barrington Passage Fire Hall. This is during the very height of the lobster season when both lobster fishermen and lobster processors will be totally preoccupied with their industry and will most likely be unable to attend any clinics.
