

BY-LAW NO. 10

EXPLOSIVES

No person shall use any explosives for blasting within One Thousand (1,000) feet of any building, public way or place except under the following conditions:

- (a) No blast shall be set off in the Municipality between nine o'clock in the afternoon and seven o'clock in the forenoon following.
- (b) All explosives, charges and sites shall be covered with heavy rope, brush, mats, or similar apparatus so as to prevent effectually the escape of broken rock, stones, turf, soil or other dangerous fragments.
- (c) No blast shall be set off while any person is within three hundred (300) feet of the charge, unless he is within a prepared pit or baffle sufficient for complete safety.
- (d) No blast shall be set off unless a warning be given at least one (1) minute before each blast.
- (e) No blast shall be set off which could reasonably cause alarm to the occupants or premises in the vicinity, or could cause any break, strain, shift, or other like damage, whatsoever in such premises.
