Subject: Expenses for Dr Yee's Medical Practice: Plexiglass Separator and Win 7 PCs x2

Dear MoB Council Members,

I hope this letter finds you keeping well and safe at this time of un-paralleled challenges.

Thank you again for the support of The MoB in providing the necessary office space and covering the expenses for enabling me to Preceptor Dalhousie Family Medicine Residents and medical students. Since the SWN FM Residency Training Program commenced in 2014, the generosity of The MoB has enabled me to train 3 FM residents. The Family Medicine residency is a 2 year program. Dr Leanne DeLong is now working in Shelburne, Dr Greg Lee in Vancouver, and Dr Madeline Arkle plans to open practice in Yarmouth upon completion of her FM training in summer of 2020. I will be Precepting my 4th FM resident in July 2020, and I will confirm this with the MoB when this arrangement is finalised. Teaching Medical Students also has a positive impact in influencing their choices of selecting SWN as their FM training site.

As you are aware the COVID-19 Pandemic has necessitated major changes in in our day to day medical practice, in keeping with ensuring the safety of our patients, medical and support staff. With this principle in mind, we have installed a Plexi glass separation around the Reception Area of the office. The COVID-19 Pandemic restrictions has also affected (decreased) significantly my work income as a Fee-For Service Physician. I felt that as a community based family physician responsible for my patients, learners (Residents and Medical Students) and employees, this health safety addition was a necessary expenditure not only for the current pandemic crisis, but for the future.

I am writing to Council to request a 50% cost-sharing re-imbusement for installing the Plexi-Glass separator. The Invoice for the total amount of \$2219.50 has been attached. I have attached some photos of the finished product. You are most welcomed to visit the Office to check it out for yourselves.

I am also writing to advise Council that the two Hewlett Packard Desktop PCs in the offices that are used for the FM Resident and other learners run Windows 7 which is no longer supported by Microsoft. As these PCs are used to run The Electronic Medical Records software for our patients (Med Access by Telus Health), the lack of security with Windows 7 can only be remedied with an upgrade to Windows 10. I tried to save Council some expense by attempting this upgrade myself. Alas, I failed and will leave this to the computer professionals at Ocean Computer. If the PCs are upgradeable to Win 10, that would probably be the simplest and cheapest way to go. If not, (these PCs are 6 years old!) we may be looking at the purchase of 2 new PCs. If the upgrade to Win 10 is possible, can Ocean Computer bill The MoB directly for the expenses?

Once again, thank you in anticipation for a favorable response to these matters.
