Please find enclosed an application for a municipal grant from the Sebim Beach Property Owners Association (SBPOA) to improve their garbage collection process and collection area. This grant application comes after a meeting with you, Councillor Jody Crook, and two members of the SPBOA on July 21, 2020 in which it was suggested that this might be an avenue to pursue.

For the past several years, The SBPOA has been totally and solely responsible for cost of the provision and maintenance of garbage collection bins and the upkeep of the garbage collection area even though these bins are used by all the other residents on the Villagedale Loop Road including all the property owners on the Sandhills Beach Road. In addition, we continually find unbagged garbage and large articles dumped there by other people.

The situation requires correction that includes the purchase of more and better made collection bins, a collaborative solution with Sandhills Road property owners regarding their garbage solution and possibly finding a way to discourage misuse by others of our garbage bins.

To this end, we respectfully request consideration of our grant application.

Social activities are organized in the summer. Property owners value their association with the Municipality of Burlington by supporting local business, attending events and volunteering.

The specific area requiring attention is the garbage collection area. Currently SBPOA provides bins for cottage owners that are also used by other Villagedale loop property owners (though they do not contribute financially). SBPOA hires a local student for the summer to keep this area clean and in good order.

The garbage bins need to be replaced and increased to meet the need and keep garbage contained.

Grant \$ will be used to create a long term, durable solution to the collection problem (misuse by outsiders) and capacity. This could include improved collection bins, surveillance camera to discourage misuse, student salary for ^{maintenance}
