Dear Warden Nickerson and Councillors:

The Town of Clark's Harbour is currently studying the options provided to us regarding the Wastewater Treatment Facility. It is an aging facility and in need of many repairs and updates. Instead of tossing a slew of bandages on a facility that isn't properly functioning to the specifications of Nova Scotia Environment and Climate Change, it was decided to pursue a new facility. The current facility has been in place since 1976, and has served us well, but it is time to move forward.

We were provided with four (4) options: options one (1) and two (2), were merely band aids on an aging facility with outdated technology and we felt that this was only a temporary solution. Option three (3), although, modern technology is being applied, the system itself seems outdated as well. Option four (4) seemed the best option, in that it is the most up to date with modern technology and the most economical to operate and will service the town and outlying areas for many years to come.

At this time, we are asking if the Municipality of Barrington would consider utilizing this facility, as you are aware, there are eleven (11) MOB residents and/or businesses that are currently utilizing the facility and there is potential for more growth. There would also be more funding options available if we were to work side by side. The Town and the Municipality has worked together in the past on projects that proved favorable, and we are hoping you would take the time to consider this proposal.

Having a modern wastewater treatment facility will benefit the Town as well as the Municipality of Barrington, if you should consider our proposal, for many years to come.
