We have answered requests from several organizations, working with Ground Search and Rescue, 4H, Lions, more recently with the Clyde River Church organization hosting car bingo with revenues shared by both; horse club sharing the horse ring and barn with them being responsible for their needs, FRA hosted their fright night on the grounds for the past tw0 years; church organization used the grounds for a family day; this year we hosted the demolition derby and burn off. A surprise was being asked to use the Ox Haul Building to hold a wedding during our last hurricane

threat. This coming year, we will be working with Special Olympics who will be hosting chip bingo during the Exhibition.

2023 our plan its to restore the Oh Haul Building, Installed in 1988, with a grant from the Municipality of \$3,500 and a loan from the Municipality, the Exhibition Committee raised funds annually to repay the loan. Now it is time to restore the 34 year old building for many more years of use. Wee have raised funds to restore the exterior and to repaint it. More is needed for the inside, which we need assistance with . We need an extra \$2,500 to complete the project. You will note in our attached pages our plans, financial needs and your request for organization information.

Ox Hauls are a benefit to the Ex and to the community. Competitors arrive with their family the day before, spend money of food and accommodations or is come cases travel trailers which assist the Ex in funds needed. Ox Hauls are a crowd pleaser with people arriving from through out Nova Scotia.

The new committee took over, working on letter writing campaign asking for volunteers to help with work that had been slated for years. Our community came out and helped. We have the new well, water running to both the horse barn and the ox haul barn. We have new safe electrical in the washrooms, and to the barns as well as in the relocated pumphouse and disconnection of electricity at the previous location.

Volunteers turned up when needed to assist with mowing of the grounds, painting and building of the washrooms, donating lighting for such, driving the forklift during the ox haul . The horse club asked if they could use the horse barn and horse ring, we were pleased to see people actually using and caring for the horse ring. This year we had horse competition at our exhibition, first time in years.

Letter writing campaign was well received, ox haul enthusiasts donated time and funds, extra activities such as car bingo, chip bingo, FRA fright night, Demolition Derby brought the revenue needed to accomplish most of our needs. Winter storage has raised funds to complete 100% of the work needed for the exterior of the Ox Haul building.

We thank the Municipality for their 2021 contribution of \$3,500 toward the new well. It is completed and was used during the 2022 Exhibition.
