2. Please identify the community, area and/or group(s) your organization serves:

Our group serves the community of Clyde River most directly, we are working towards setting up a safe meeting spot at the former Church that can be used for a variety of things - gatherings, meetings, counselling worship, celebrations, fundraisers, and concerts, just name a few. It is our intention to make this a welcoming space for all individuals and groups that may want to utilize this space, whether it be for personal use or another organization. While the building will remain a church in appearance with the main floor having pews and a pulpit, the building will be for the community and will not be associated with any particular religion. We pride ourselves on being a community minded group, whose main goal was to ensure that a beautiful, historic, icon did not end up demolished and the local cemetery did not end up closed to future burials.

3. Please describe your organization's specific project/program/service:

We are seeking funds to purchase materials/supplies (paint, cleaning supplies, drywall, kitchen appliances, etc.) to aid in the on-going repairs and improvement of the former St. Matthew's United Church in Clyde River. On July 9th, 2021, the steeple of St. Matthew's United Church in Clyde River was struck by lightning. In the days and weeks following this, many people shared their memories of St. Matthew's and expressed their desire to see it repaired and remain a central icon in the community of Clyde River. Our group, Clyde River Society & Cemetery, was formed, whose goal is to secure the building against weather, its restoration for future use, and the general preservation of the building and cemetery, to be utilized by the community. Ownership of the building was legally transferred to our organization by the United Church. Thanks to donations and insurance funds we have been able to repair the structural damage, but now need more funds to repair other parts of the building specifically the basement, which houses the kitchen and a large open space. This space is crucial for our plans to make the building a gathering place for events, concerts, meetings, and fundraisers.
