With pinpoint accuracy, surgeons can safely and precisely remove the cancerous tissue and the required margins around it, while improving patient comfort before and during surgery.

In Canada, approximately 28,600 women are diagnosed with breast cancer yearly.

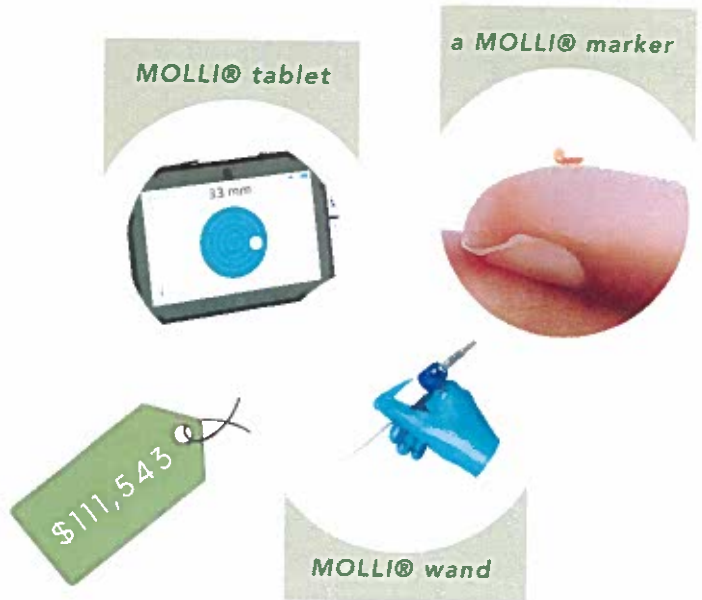

With the MOLLI® system, however, the localization procedure takes about five minutes and can happen within 30 days prior to the surgery, reducing the length of a very stressful day for patients and allowing them to focus on their surgical experience. As radiologist Dr. Beth Furey tells us, *"The MOLLI® marker allows radiologists to precisely localize breast cancers for removal without using cumbersome wires, improving patient comfort before and during surgery."*

Surgeons use the MOLLI® system to remove lesions in the breast with increased efficiency and accuracy - no more worrying about a wire marker moving during surgery or becoming dislodged, causing the localization to be inaccurate.

## About Yarmouth Hospital Foundation

### Mission Statement

*To support and enhance our hospital as a community and regional centre of excellence in health care.*

### Quick Facts:

- Established in 1970, Yarmouth Hospital Foundation (YHF) provides a way for town and municipal units, individuals, businesses and community groups to support the Yarmouth Regional Hospital and its number one priority: building better health care for families and individuals of Yarmouth, Digby and Shelburne Counties.
- Through the generosity of our donors, YHF has contributed close to \$29 million in support of our regional health centre. This figure includes \$10 million raised for hospital expansion in the mid to late nineties.
- Currently, twenty-three individuals from Yarmouth, Digby and Shelburne counties serve on the YHF Board. All board members are volunteers.
- On average, during the past ten years, YHF has contributed in excess of \$800,000 annually towards equipment and/or infrastructure. Examples: digital radiography and ultrasound units; 55 ceiling lifts, MRI, medication management system, CT scan, infant ventilators & incubators, laparoscopic suites (OR), lab equipment, renal dialysis units, cardiac equipment, cancer center, wellness center, virtual care etc.
- Sources of funding: annual appeals (Spring & Christmas), memorial donations, monthly and general donations, staff lottery, community fundraising events, bequests (gift in will), major gifts, gifts of securities and the WE CARE Radiothon.
- In August of 2021, YHF received the prestigious distinction of accreditation granted by the Standards Program with Imagine Canada.
