

2024-2025 Capital

Project Descriptions

This is a preliminary list of projects that have been identified as capital for 2023/2024. The listing is being provided for review and feedback. If there are any objections or ideas of new capital projects, they should be raised now as capital projects have a serious impact on the overall budget.

- **Pool Lift \$ 15,000**
Purchase a pool lift to make the pool accessible to those with mobility issues.
- **Curling Club Heat Pump \$ 16,000**
A request has been made by the Curling Club to install two heat pumps to assist with cooling the building.
- **Arena Boards \$ 55,000**
The boards surrounding the ice surface require replacement. They are original with the facility and are becoming weak.
- **Barrington Ballfield Lights \$ 75,000**
Existing poles and lights are in poor condition. Total replacement with LED lights.
- **Barrington Ballfield Multi-Purpose Building \$ 234,000**
Build a multi-purpose building at the Barrington Ballfield containing public washrooms, storage space and canteen.
- **Admin Office Roof \$ 165,000**
The administration office roof requires replacement. It is leaking in several places. The sections above the multi-purpose room and conference room were done about 10 years ago and will not be replaced.
- **Library Pond Fence \$ 40,000**
The fence surrounding the duck pond at the library requires replacing as it is in poor condition.
- **Playground Equipment \$ 30,000**
Replacing existing swings at the playground on Sherose Island.
- **Snow plow \$ 14,000**
Replace 2005 snow plow.



- **Property Services Vehicle \$ 50,000**
Purchase new property services vehicle.
- **Kiack Brook Parking Lot \$ \$ 80,000**
Re-pave Kiack brook parking lot and install 2 EV chargers.
- **Connection Soccer Field to Sterl's Road \$ 20,000**
Build road to connect Soccer field and Sterl's Road.
- **Community Health Centre \$ 9,000,000**
This project will see a 14,000 sq./ft. healthcare centre built in the Barrington Passage area. It will serve as a central location for our residents to access a variety of medical and paramedical services and will help our community support and retain our current healthcare professionals and recruit others. The current years budget would be **\$ 1,630,450** as the project would be over 2 fiscal years.
- **Recreation Centre \$ 9,500,000**
This project is to replace the recreation centre on Sherose Island. The new facility will be joined with the arena via a shared entrance and will include a walking track, multi-purpose rooms, and kitchen facilities.
- **Digital Sign \$ TBD**
Replace existing sign near the Barrington Search and Rescue Building with a digital sign.
- **Sidewalk Extension \$ 474,303**
Extend Barrington Passage sidewalk to the new Healthcare Centre, funded by the Sustainable Services Growth Fund.
- **Brass Hill Treatment Plant Upgrades \$ 1,137,000**
Complete Phase 2 Brass Hill Treatment upgrades with ICIP funds received.
