1. GENERAL

- 1.1 The work shall include all labour, equipment, materials and incidentals necessary to provide the preparation and paving of Cat Rock Drive, Spruce Drive, and Nicholas Drive within the Municipality of the District of Barrington.
- 1.2 Finished asphalt surface not to have irregularities exceeding 5mm when checked with a 4.5m straight edge placed in any direction.
- 1.3 All on site signage and traffic control is the responsibility of the Contractor. Flagmen and signages are to be provided in accordance with the Nova Scotia Department of Labour's Temporary Workplace Traffic Control Manual, latest edition.
- 1.4 The Contractor shall guarantee his work against any defects/ defaults including bleeding, shoving, slippage, cracking, or rutting for a period of one full year from date of acceptance of the work including the date of acceptance of any corrected deficiencies.
- 1.5 The Contractor shall indemnify and save harmless the Municipality against and from all damages, claims, suits, demands, actions, judgements, and cost of any kind and description as a result of injury or property damage resulting from the performance of this tender or through any improper or defective equipment used by the Contractor or through any act or omission on the part of the Contractor, his employees or sub-contractors.
- 1.6 The Contractor shall be paid at the full completion of the project.
- 1.7 Contractors submitting tenders will only be considered if the required Submission Tender Forms are fully completed and returned to the Municipal Office at 2447, Highway #3, Barrington, prior to the submission deadline.

2. PROJECT DETAILS

- 2.1 Project will be to prepare and pave Cat Rock Drive, Spruce Drive, and Nicholas Drive, within the Municipality of the District of Barrington. These three streets are the property and responsibility of the Municipality of the District of Barrington.
- 2.2 All measurements are estimates only, and MoDB makes no representation to the accuracy of these measurements. Contactors tendering are responsible for the verification of measurements.
- 2.3 Cat Rock Drive will be paved at a width of 18 ft to 21 ft (tapered to adjoining road), with a cul de sac at the end with a radius of 32 ft 6 in. The length of this drive is approximately 316m or 1035ft.
- 2.4 Spruce Drive will be paved at a width of 18 to 21 ft (tapered to adjoining road), with a widening at the end of the drive for vehicle turning. The length of this drive is approximately 1565 ft or 477m.
- 2.5 Nicholas Drive will be paved at a width of 18 to 21ft (tapered to adjoining road). The length of this drive is approximately 473 ft or 144m.
- 2.6 All roads are to receive the following:
 - Place on average of 2" type 1 gravel
 - Compact gravel surface
 - Place 2.5" of asphalt

3. DISCLAIMER

- 3.1 The Municipality reserves the right to reject any and all tenders, to waive any and all formalities or informalities, and to disregard all non-conforming, non-responsive or conditional tenders. In addition, the Municipality reserves the right to negotiate contract changes with the finalist tenderer, and/or to award a contract to any tenderer in the Municipality's sole discretion. The Municipality reserves the right to reject the tenders of any and all proponents if the Municipality believes that it would not be in the best interest of the Municipality to make an award whether because the tenders are non-responsive or because the tenders are found to be not responsible or fail to meet any other pertinent standard or criterion established by the Municipality.

The Municipality may conduct such investigations as the Municipality deems necessary to assist in the evaluation of any tender, to establish the best tender and to otherwise make its selection.

4. TENDER EVALUATIONS

- 4.1 The tenders will be evaluated by representatives of the Municipality of the District of Barrington in their sole discretion.
- 4.2 The lowest or any tender may not necessarily be accepted. Such things as past performance, workmanship, references, and start/ completion dates will be taken into consideration when awarding the tender.
