PROPOSED PROPERTY ASSESSED CLEAN ENERGY
(PACE) PROGRAM BY-LAW

Barrington Municipal Council is considering the adoption of a “Property Assessed Clean Energy (PACE) Program By-Law”.

This by-law makes provision for an owner of a Qualifying Property located within the Municipality of Barrington to apply to the Municipality for financing of a Clean Energy Upgrade for their property.

A Clean Energy Upgrade will result in substantially improved energy efficiency, the generation of renewable energy or reduced greenhouse gas emissions. Upgrades could include caulking, weather stripping, duct/air sealing, energy efficient windows and doors, heat pumps, wood or pellet stoves, solar thermal panels, etc.

A copy of the proposed By-law may be inspected at the Municipal Office, in the Administrative Centre, located at #2447, Highway #3, Barrington, N.S., between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday.

Any representation by interested persons concerning the adoption of the proposed Property Assessed Clean Energy (PACE) Program By-Law may be made at the August 28, 2017 Council meeting, which will be held in the Council Chambers, in the Administrative Centre, in Barrington, N.S. The adoption of this by-law will be discussed at 7:00 p.m.
