

# GARBAGE

## SOLID COLOUR BAGS

### Any non-compostable or recyclable materials

- Pet litter/waste
- Empty coffee pods (coffee in compost)
- Styrofoam™ (meat trays, etc)
- Toothpaste tubes
- Empty motor oil containers (lids on)
- Wallpaper/taped gift wrap
- Pet food bags (plastic lined)
- Chocolate bar wrappers/chip bags (mix of plastic & aluminum)
- Cereal box liners
- Light bulbs
- Broken glass (wrapped)
- Diapers
- Broken ceramics, porcelain
- Alkaline batteries
- Clothing & shoes
- Vacuum cleaner bags
- Dryer sheets & lint
- Cigarette butts
- Caulking tubes
- Broken toys
- Microwave popcorn bags
- Small appliances
- Personal hygiene products
- Used tin foil
- Alkaline batteries
- Plastic dishes & cutlery
- CD's & DVD's
- School binders
- Rusted tins/cans

**Absolutely no organics or recyclables are to be placed in your garbage bags.**

## OTHER DISPOSAL METHODS

**Tires** (rims removed) can be returned, up to 4 at a time, to any tire retailer in Nova Scotia

**Pharmaceuticals and drugs** - please contact your local Pharmacy for proper disposal instructions.

**Propane Tanks** - larger than 20lbs must go back to distributor (Superior, Speedy, etc)

# RECYCLABLES

## CLEAR OR BLUE BAGS

### PAPER/FIBRE PRODUCTS

- Newspaper
- Paper Egg Cartons
- Cardboard
- Boxboard (eg. Cereal boxes)
- Tissue Boxes
- Phone Books
- Catalogues
- Paper, flyers and magazines
- Softcover books
- Hardcover books
- Empty paper towel/ toilet paper rolls
- Cigarette packages (foil liner in garbage)

Cardboard should be flattened and bundled

### BEVERAGE CONTAINERS

- Glass jars & bottles
- Beer & Liquor bottles
- Pop & water bottles
- Juice & milk cartons
- Tim Horton/McDonald's/Paper Cups (lids removed and rinsed clean **OR** recycle lid and **com**-post cup)

### ALL PLASTICS

- Grocery bags
- Clean plastic food bags
- Shampoo bottles
- Plastic tubs & lids
- Cleaning fluid bottles

### TIN/ALUMINUM

- Steel tin food cans
- Clean Aluminum foil/pie plates

Beverage containers (excluding milk) can be taken to your local ENVIRO-DEPOT™ for a refund.

**ALL recyclables should be clean and dry to avoid rejection.**

Paper can be left on cans, windows in envelopes and plastic sleeves on Kleenex boxes

# ORGANICS

## GREEN CART/ORGANIC CONTAINER

### ALL FOOD WASTE INCLUDING

- Meat, fish & bones
- Egg shells
- Tea bags & coffee grounds
- All fruits & vegetables
- Cooking oil & fat

### SOILED AND/OR WET PAPER INCLUDING

- Tim Horton/McDonald's/ Paper coffee cups (lids removed & placed in recycle bag)
- Pizza boxes
- Waxed boxes (pie shells, etc)
- Paper Towels
- Napkins
- Paper sugar, flour & potato bags
- Waxed Paper
- Non-metallic gift wrap (tape removed)
- Leaves, garden waste, plants or weeds
- Sawdust, wood chips or grass clippings

**Absolutely NO plastic bags, metals or glass are to be put in your compost.**

**TIP:** Line green carts with boxboard or paper/compostable liners to ensure easy removal of waste during collection. Biodegradable bags **MUST** bear this logo to be accepted.

## RECYCLABLES BLUE/CLEAR BAGS



Clean bottles

## HAZARDOUS WASTE LOCATED AT THE C&D LANDFILL SITE



**Empty/Full/Partly Full Paint Cans** can also be taken to the Enviro-Depot



**All Aerosol cans (empty & with substance)**



**Used oil filters**  
Place in the metal barrel at your waste oil site.



**Used Boat Oil**  
Empty into waste oil tank.
