**POSITION:** Aquatic Instructor / Lifeguard  
**SUPERVISOR:** Aquatic Coordinator  
**AUTHORITY:** Make recommendations on swimming classes  
Administer daily pool schedule  
Administer pool rules and regulations  
Actions as required to carry out responsibilities

**RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Instructing the Red Cross Learn to Swim Program
- Lifeguard swims when scheduled
- Enforce all pool rules and regulations
- Collect public swims fees
- Maintain a safe environment for pool users
- Vacuum pool each morning
- Regular check of all equipment
- Test pool water, daily at specific times
- Maintain records for programs, accidents, statistics awards, etc
- Backwash pool filters as required
- Attend staff meetings
- DAILY checks on locker rooms at established times and clean bathrooms areas
- Attend all in-service sessions
- Deal with all problems in a prompt and mannerly way
- See that all policies as set down by the Dept. of Health, Red Cross, Royal Lifesaving and the Municipality of Barrington are followed
- Any other duties that may arise as determined for the operation of the pool in a safe and enjoyable environment.

**CERTIFICATION:** Minimum qualifications –  
National Lifeguard Service  
Saint John Ambulance Standard First Aid  
Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)  
Red Cross / Water Safety Instructors

**WORK WEEK:** Approximately 40 hours per week or as worked out with the Aquatic Coordinator (rotation shifts)

**SALARY:** \$11.40

**STARTING DATE:** June 26, 2017 or as required

**FINISHING DATE:** August 25, 2017
